Serenity Consultants Inc. has been talking and praying about opening a woman's program since our first year of operation in 2006. They say that things happen in God's time. This was true for me, but I now believe that it is always God's time, that God answers our prayers when we are ready, and only God knows when that is.

Well, we must be ready because the House of Freedom \& Miracles woman's addiction recovery program has officially become an undertaking of Serenity Consultants Inc., and we are about to close on a house owned by Talbert House at 334 McGregor Ave. in Mt. Auburn (pictured above). Joy! Joy! Joy! This will increase the number of bed spaces for women from ten to eighteen. Our next venture will be preparing to begin to be ready to
returning to us for help. This has significantly increased the total number of addicts/alcoholics we work with on a daily bases, not to mention our Alumni Committee who assist with house projects and community service. They have planned a Super Bowl party for themselves and all residents in our programs.

We have also established independent living housing for alumni. We have our Bassett House, with three two bedroom apartments adjacent to the Serenity House property, and Victory House a four bedroom house located in Milford Ohio on the Little Miami River. Of course now we will need independent living housing for women. With the purchase of the property on McGregor we will have the ability to serve a total of fortyfour residents. A true blessing.

So where do we go from here? Not far without outside help. Yes, we always are in need of financial support, but given our path and recent growth we are in urgent need of community service and in-kind support.

We need help cleaning, fixing, and preparing the new woman's location for residency. We also need in-kind donations, including furniture, house hold products, and many other regularly needed items.
